### BGU Discounts & Scholarships (“B” Country Designation Students only)

Because “B” Country Designation students are paying discounted tuition rates, they are not eligible for any other institutional scholarships or discounts. The one exception to this is the BGU PT Tuition Scholarship, reflected in the Tuition rates listed on page 1.

### Proof of Financial Support Requirements

<b>“B” Country Designation Students</b>	<p>“B” Country international students must submit proof of financial support documentation including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>A Proof of Financial Support letter (BGU provides the template form for this)</li> <li>Supporting documentation giving evidence that the supporter completing the letter has the means to provide the support indicated. (Detailed on the proof of financial support letter)</li> </ul>
<b>Supporters &amp; Sponsors</b>	<p>Many international students are fully or partially supported to attend BGU by one or more churches, ministries and individuals for the purpose of investing in future missionaries or leader in a specific ministry.</p> <p>We suggest you talk with your local church, missions committee and individuals about committing to your training with a one-time or on-going gift. This can be applied to tuition or any other school expenses.</p>

### Making Payments (“B” Country Designation Students only)

You may choose between two payment options:

1. Pay for the entire year in advance by the payment due date of your first term (no Pay in Advance Discount is available)
2. Pay for the entire semester by the payment due date of each term.
