### BGU Discounts & Scholarships (“C” Country Designation Students only)

Because “C” Country Designation students are paying our lowest tuition rates, they are not eligible for any other institutional scholarships or discounts. The one exception to this is the BGU PT Tuition Scholarship, reflected in the Tuition rates listed on page 1.

### Proof of Financial Support Requirements

<b>“C” Country Designation Students</b>	Proof of financial support documentation is not required of C Country Designation students.
<b>Supporters &amp; Sponsors</b>	Many international students are fully or partially supported to attend BGU by one or more churches, ministries and individuals for the purpose of investing in future missionaries or leader in a specific ministry.  We suggest you talk with your local church, missions committee and individuals about committing to your training with a one-time or on-going gift. This can be applied to tuition or any other school expenses.

### Making Payments (“C” Country Designation Students only)

1. “C” Country Designation Students are not eligible for a payment plan.
2. You are required to pay for the entire year in advance by the payment due date for your first semester.
