2018-19 FINANCIAL COMMUNICATION STATEMENT OF UNDERSTANDING

Access to Financial Information

Bethany Global University makes the following financial information available to the public:

- tuition costs
- room and board costs
- required fees
- optional fees, which are dependent upon the student's specific needs (such as medical coverage and parking fees)
- estimates on variable costs related to internship (travel, housing, ministry costs etc, which vary depending on global economy, country location and other factors)

This information is posted on our website at bethanygu.edu, in the shared files at bethanygu.populiweb.org and in the university catalog. This information is also presented in the required online Orientation Seminar for new freshmen, requiring their signature. In addition, it is sent to new students in print form upon acceptance and approximately 6 weeks prior to enrollment for new students and approximately 1 month prior to the start of each subsequent school year (new international students and students living overseas are asked to refer to the documents online as print versions are not sent overseas).

Financial Aid

All students who wish to avail of the tuition-paid financial model of the university are required to complete the FAFSA annually and accept all Federal Pell Grants offered. Students who complete the FAFSA are also required to complete a VFAO student interview online annually as part of the financial aid application process.

Instructions and links are sent by Admissions upon acceptance for new students and by the end of the fall semester for all continuing students. Additional information about applying for federal student aid is available on our website at bethanygu.edu, in the Financial Aid Office found in Admissions, and in the shared files at bethanygu.populiweb.org.

Bethany Global University makes additional institutional financial aid available to all qualifying students. The listing of available aid, including criteria to qualify, is posted on our website at bethanygu.edu, in the shared files at bethanygu.populiweb.org and in the university catalog.

Important: Only the Financial Aid Director has the authority to award institutional financial aid and only the Director of Student Services and Student Accounts Coordinator may approve payment plans.
