### BGU Discounts & Scholarships (“A” Country Designation Students only)

<b>Campus Visit Event Scholarship</b>	Attend one of our semi-annual Preview Campus Visit Events.	<b>\$300</b>
<b>Individual Campus Visit Scholarship</b>	Arrange an individual campus visit with the Admissions Office (cannot be combined with Campus Visit Event Scholarship).	<b>\$200</b>
<b>Pay in Advance Discount</b>	Pay for the entire year in full by the first payment deadline. Non-residential students (living off-campus or in non-dorm housing) are ineligible.	<b>\$300</b>

### Proof of Financial Support Requirements

<b>“A” Country Designation Students</b>	<p>“A” Country international students must submit proof of financial support documentation including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A Proof of Financial Support letter (BGU provides the template form for this)</li> <li>• Supporting documentation giving evidence that the supporter completing the letter has the means to provide the support indicated. (Detailed on the proof of financial support letter)</li> </ul>
<b>Supporters &amp; Sponsors</b>	<p>Many international students are fully or partially supported to attend BGU by one or more churches, ministries and individuals for the purpose of investing in future missionaries or leader in a specific ministry.</p> <p>We suggest you talk with your local church, missions committee and individuals about committing to your training with a one-time or on-going gift. This can be applied to tuition or any other school expenses.</p>

### Making Payments (“A” Country Designation Students only)

<p>You may choose between three payment options:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Pay for the entire year in advance by the payment due date of your first term (and receive a \$300 Pay in Advance Discount).</li> <li>2. Pay for the entire semester by the payment due date of each term.</li> <li>3. Request a payment plan by contacting the Student Billing Office (contact information, below). The payment plan fee is \$150 per semester. The Student Billing Office can provide exact dollar amounts you will owe for each payment.</li> </ol>
