Married student living off-campus: Typically, only married students are allowed to live off-campus. In this case, the student does not qualify for the BGU Tuition Scholarship. Only the PT Tuition Scholarship/FWC Award and the Pell Grant, if eligible, is applied to tuition and there is no room and board cost. Therefore, the total annual tuition cost will range from \$4612.50 to \$12,982.50, depending on Pell eligibility.

Previous bachelor's degree or already reached lifetime Pell eligibility: Students that already have a previous bachelor's degree from another school or have already used their lifetime Pell eligibility of 6 years at another school(s) cannot receive Pell; therefore, they are partially eligible for Tuition-Paid. They receive \$7,582 of BGU Tuition Scholarship and the \$3,337.50 PT Tuition scholarship stays the same. Therefore, the total cost increases from \$6,881 to \$10,281.
